Annual General Assembly of the Moroccan Coalition for Water "COALMA"

In accordance with the legislative provisions governing non-for-profit organizations and its bylaws, COALMA held its Annual General Assembly on June 20, 2023, at the headquarters of CGEM in Casablanca.

Chaired by Prof. Houria TAZI SADEQ, the assembly validated the agenda, reviewed and updated its bylaws, approved the moral and financial reports, and granted discharge to the Presidency and the Executive Committee.

The General Assembly expressed its sincere gratitude to the outgoing governance bodies, members of the Scientific Committee, members, and staff of COALMA for their dedication and the high quality of the actions carried out during the mandate. Special thanks were extended to the partners and supporters, including the media. The Assembly congratulated President Prof. Houria TAZI SADEQ.

The Assembly unanimously rejected the President's wish not to stand for re-election and solicited her to preside over COALMA for the upcoming mandate due to her extensive expertise and unwavering commitment to the association's mission.

Lastly, the General Assembly proceeded with the election of members of the Coordination Committee, who will convene in the coming days to elect the members of its Executive Committee.

The Scientific Committee is chaired by the COALMA presidency, which has been mandated to compose its members.
